ELECTORAL REDISTRIBUTION

I refer to the proposed redistribution of ACT electoral boundaries notified in The Canberra Times of 12 May.

I wish to object to the proposed redistribution insofar as it transfers the suburbs of Forest and Red Hill from Kurrajong to Murrumbidgee.

These suburbs are a logical part of the Kurrajong electorate. Geographically they are separated from Murrumbidgee by the Red Hill ridge. Socially, their focus lies with the other Inner South suburbs, the local business centres and the institutions (such as churches) of the Inner South.

On the basis of these factors, I submit that Forest and Red Hill should remain in Kurrajong.
