An appointment does not take effect until it has been entered in the Commission's register of reporting agents. It remains in effect until a written notice of resignation or revocation of the appointment is received by the Commission or the agent dies.

An entity that appoints two reporting agents must have administrative arrangements to determine which agent may be responsible for obligations under the Act.

Appointment of reporting agent

An MLA or candidate may appoint up to two reporting agents. To end the appointment of an agent, the MLA/candidate must give written notice to the commissioner stating the appointment has ended; or the agent must give written notice stating they have resigned.
