**Subject:** Molonglo Redistribution

To whom it may concern

I am writing to object to the most recent proposed redistribution which sees north canberra split between Molonglo and Gininderra, and would request a return to the original proposal which say Crace and Palmerston moved to Ginninderra. As a resident of Molonglo, and therefore a citizen affected by this proposal, I am deeply concerned about the impact of this proposal on my community. The North Canberra community is a well defined, engaged, and dynamic community built around the environmental, town planning and social factors that define inner north Canberra. Moreover we are represented as a community by the North Canberra Community Council exactly because of the commonality of interests that define this unique community. I understand that one of the main reasons for the new proposed redistribution was concerns by Gungahlin residents about the impact of the original redistribution on their community. In response I would say that consequently I would expect the same treatment of the North Canberra community and further that the new proposed redistribution has a much larger impact on the North Canberra community than the original proposal to remove Palmerstone and Crace ( which in the later case less than half built) to Gininderra.
