NOTICE OF CASUAL VACANCY IN THE ACT LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

As a result of the resignation of Mrs Giulia Jones MLA, Member for Murrumbidgee, there is a casual vacancy in the ACT Legislative Assembly.

Any person who was an unsuccessful candidate for the electorate of Murrumbidgee in the 2020 ACT Legislative Assembly election may apply to contest this vacancy in accordance with section 192 of the *Electoral Act 1992*.

Application forms are available from the ACT Electoral Commission, Nara Centre, 3 Constitution Avenue, Canberra City between the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm on weekdays, or may be obtained by contacting the Commission on 6205 0033 or at elections@act.gov.au.

**Completed applications must reach the ACT Electoral Commissioner
by noon on 20 June 2022.**

The names of the candidates who have applied to contest the vacancy will be publicly declared at 12:30 pm on 20 June 2022 at the ACT Legislative Assembly, under COVID Safe provisions. If more than one candidate applies to contest the vacancy, a recount of the votes received by Mrs Giulia Jones at the 2020 election will be conducted immediately after the declaration of candidates at the ACT Legislative Assembly, in order to determine the successful candidate.
